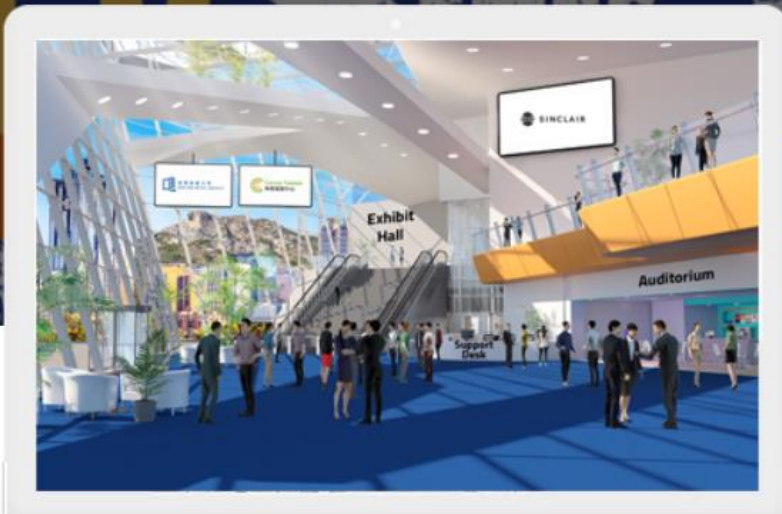

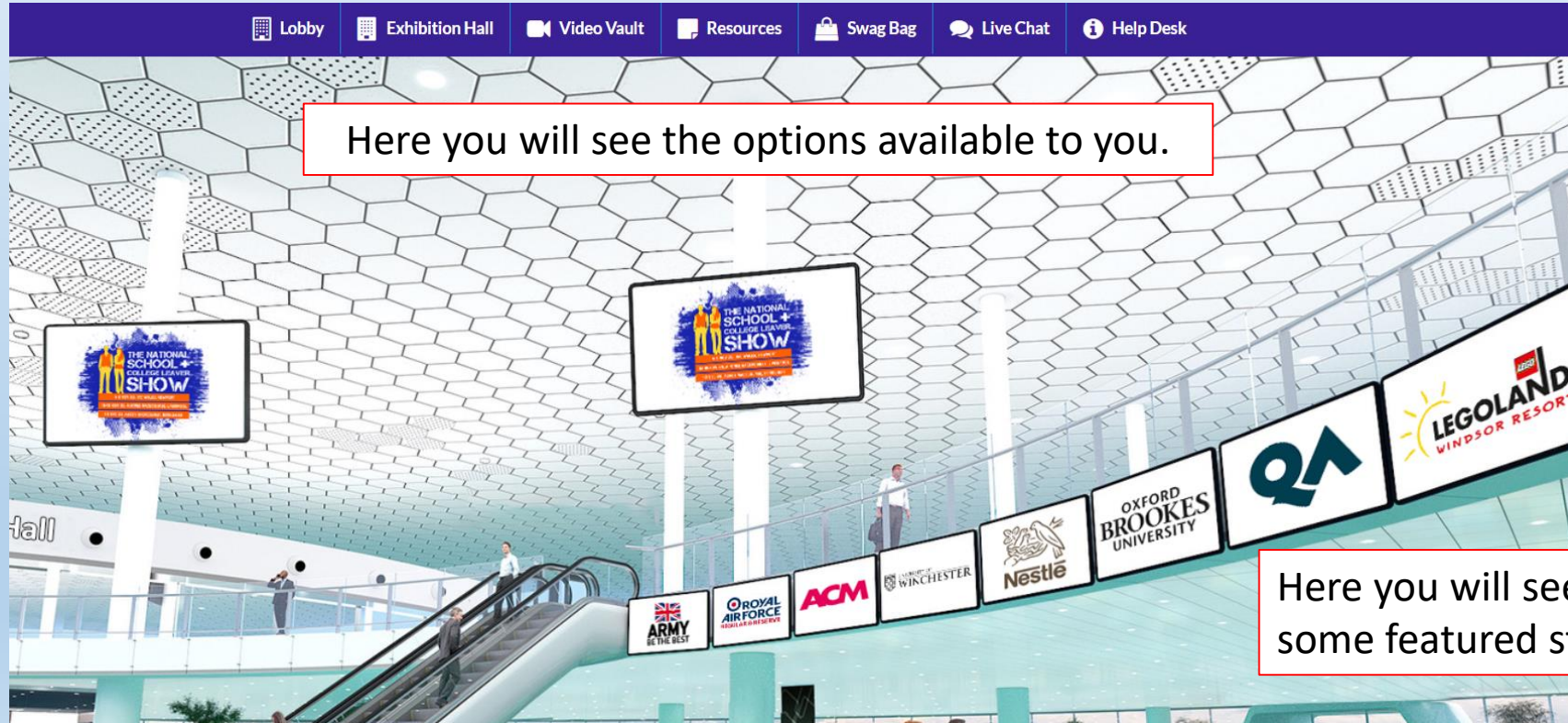

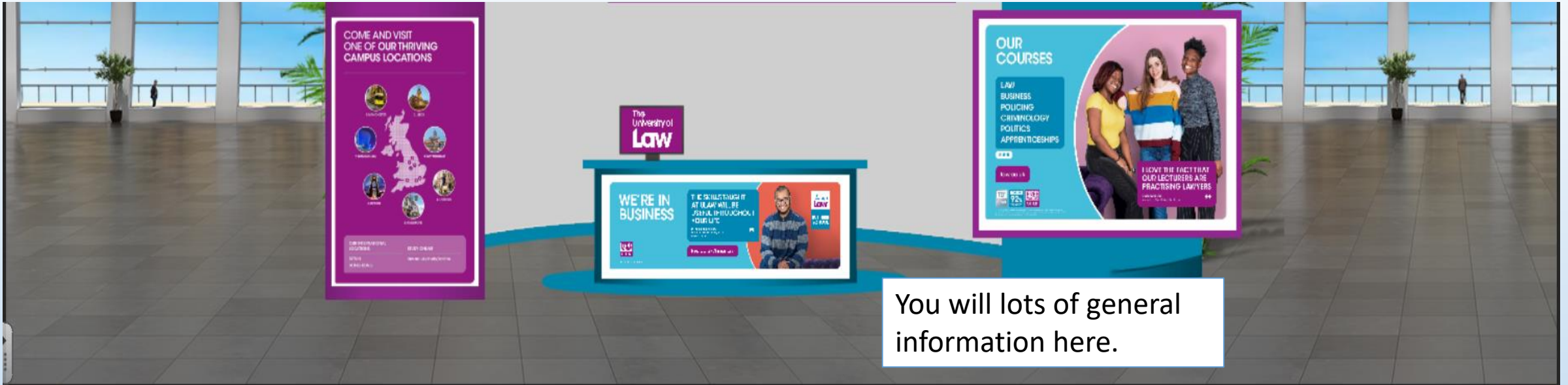
How it Works

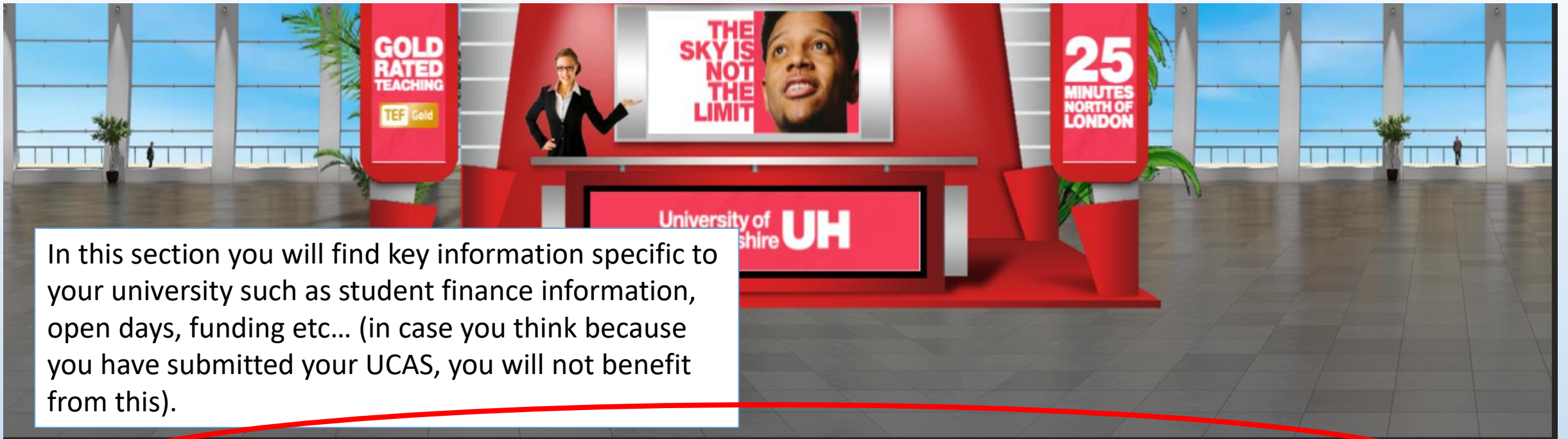


